'The Grotto' Prayer Group for young people: In parishes that I have been in, I have had a prayer group which prays the holy rosary and a meditation exercise based on the Gospel for the Sunday. It is a great chance for young people to come together to pray and learn about their faith and grow in knowledge of Jesus' life. 'The Grotto' stems from the famous grotto at Lourdes where St Bernadette, a young 14-year-old girl, received the apparitions of the Blessed Virgin Mary. We are blessed with young people in this parish who are eager to grow in faith together. The first session will take place in St Joseph's church at the chapel of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Saturday 11 May, 6.00 pm. The prayer will last about 40 mins. After which, the Mass will follow. #### Saints we celebrate this week:

**St John of Beverley**: He was a monk at Whitby who was made the bishop od Hexham (Near Newcastle) in 687 AD. In 705 AD he was translated to York (Transferred). He built a monastery at Beverley where he retired to at the end of his career. He died in 721 AD and is buried there.

**St John of Avila**: He was born in 1499. He was a Spanish priest, preacher, author, mystic and a Doctor of the Church. He is called the 'Apostle of Andalusia'. He died in 1569.
