'The Grotto' Prayer Group for young people: In parishes that I have been in, I have had a prayer group which prays the holy rosary and a meditation exercise based on the Gospel for the Sunday. It is a great chance for young people to come together to pray and learn about their faith and grow in knowledge of Jesus' life. 'The Grotto' stems from the famous grotto at Lourdes where St Bernadette, a young 14-year-old girl, received the apparitions of the Blessed Virgin Mary. We are blessed with young people in this parish who are eager to grow in faith together. The first session will take place in St Joseph's church at the chapel of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Saturday 11 May, 6.00 pm. The prayer will last about 40 mins. After which, the Mass will follow. Further prayer meetings times will be made then, but it is usually every two or three weeks. Please do complete a form to allow your child to come along.
