St Rita of Cascia: Despite an early desire to enter into religious life, she was married aged 18 to an abusive husband. After his death and that of her children, she joined the Augustinian Order at Cascia in Italy, aged 36. She lived for 40 years in the convent spending her days in prayer and works of charity. She never lost her faith despite great trials. She is an example to us all of perseverance in suffering. She is an excellent patron to help with your personal sufferings.

<u>St Bede</u>: Was born at Wearmouth (Sunderland) in 673 AD. He entered the monastery at Mount Wearmouth. He became a priest and historian. He wrote many works on scripture and history, in particular England's first history book 'The Ecclesiastical History of the English People'.
