Consultation about buying new Mass Books.

Several Parishioners have commented that the prayers of the Mass are no longer included on the Sunday Message. It has been decided to consult with parishioners about other options.

- Buy sets of Mass Books like the ones used at St Patrick's. Six sets would be required to cover the 3 Liturgical Years. Each book costs about £6 each.
- Buy Sunday Missals to be used at Mass. These cover all 3 Liturgical years. These cost about £20 each.
- Continue with the Sunday Message at a cost of about £700 per year.

If changes were made it could be part of the commemorations for the Centenary Celebrations for our two churches, stickers being put in the front of books. There could also be an option for books to be dedicated to deceased loved ones if people were willing to contribute to their cost.

It is important that Parishioners make their views known about what they would like, so on 9th/10th August samples of books will be available to view at the back of church after each Mass and people will be available for you to state your preference (anonymously). The final decision will obviously be made by our new Parish Priest.

CAFOD APPEAL Starvation is spreading across Gaza. As the Israeli government's siege starves the people of Gaza, people are being killed at food distribution sites.
