# Consultation about buying new Mass Books.

Several Parishioners have commented that the prayers of the Mass are no longer included on the Sunday Message. It has been decided to consult with parishioners about other options.

- Buy sets of Mass Books like the ones used at St Patrick's. Six sets would be required to cover the 3 Liturgical Years. Each book costs about £6 each.
- Buy Sunday Missals to be used at Mass.
   These cover all 3 Liturgical years. These cost about £20 each.
- Continue with the Sunday Message at a cost of about £700 per year.

There could also be an option for books to be dedicated to deceased loved ones if people were willing to contribute to their cost.
