Starvation is spreading across Gaza. As the Israeli government's siege starves the people of Gaza, people are being killed at food distribution sites. This is not just a humanitarian crisis it's the systematic erosion of what makes us human. The UK government is right to condemn Israel's current actions in Gaza and suspend trade negotiations with Israel.
