### General Health & Safety

- You have a responsibility for your own

The walk will follow the canal tow path so  
the safety of children on this part of the  
route is the responsibility of the accompa-  
nying responsible adult. Please place your  
child on the inside of the path.
- If you injure yourself, inform your walk lead-  
ers who will take the necessary action.
- First aiders will be present throughout the  
walk.
- If you need to move forward or drop back  
that is fine, as long as you make one of the  
walk leaders aware. Do not go ahead of the  
lead Marshal.
- We will be walking on tracks and paths,  
some of which may be quite uneven, stony  
or muddy at times. You should wear correct  
footwear, which is walking boots or walking  
shoes that support the feet and ankles.  
Trainers with a good tread are acceptable  
but you may get wet feet. You are advised  
to bring a waterproof coat
- If it is forecast a hot day, please bring sun  
cream and a sun hat!
