Parish Mass Books -

Commencing First Sunday of Advent

We are introducing Parish Mass books at the start of Advent. The first books has been purchased but a further 5 books will need to be purchased to cover the three-year liturgical cycle. Each book costs £6. The Parish Mass books are used weekly at Mass and provide the texts and prayers for each celebration. Parishioners may want to consider buying their own Mass book for your own personal use. Alternatively, parishioners may purchase a Sunday Missal from the CTS. The Sunday Missal contains all the Sunday readings for the year in a single volume or there is option to buy a Missal that covers the full three-year liturgical cycle.

You are warmly invited to support our parish by choosing one of the following options:

- Donate towards the cost of the Parish Mass books for communal use
- Purchase your own individual Mass book or full set - £6 per book or £36 for a full set.
- Buy a Sunday Missal from CTS £9.95 for oneyear, £19.95 for three-year.
