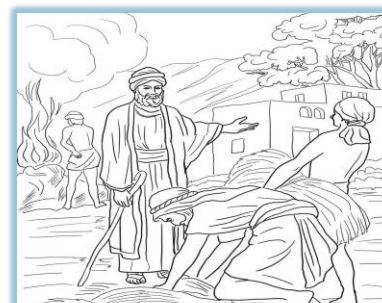

The next meeting of the LIVE SIMPLY group will be on Monday 10th August from 6.00 p.m. to 7.00 p.m. in the Parish Centre. We are learning a lot about how we can help to respect and preserve God's beautiful earth and we thought we would share some things with you. Do you know you can recycle your tablet blister packs? This can be done at some Boots the Chemist stores and Superdrug. For Boots you can download an app to collect points for certain blister packs. It's a little complicated but some of us are having a go. Processors like MYGroup shred and separate the bonded foil and plastic. The metal is smelted for reuse, while the plastic is pressed into a durable, plywood-like building material.

The next SVP meeting is on Tuesday 11th August in the Parish Centre from 6.00p.m. to 6.55. pm. New members are always welcome. The Pope has encouraged people to join believing members get much out of joining to help others.
