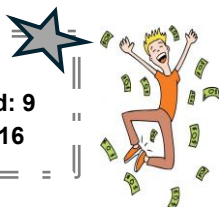

Parish Pastoral Council (PPC)

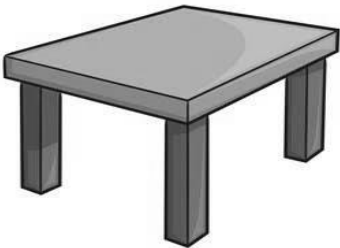
